- are not "on topic"
- are excessively long or negative in tone.
- make unsubstantiated claims

We will delete comments, without notice, that :

- offer no means of contacting the originator
- contain advertising or spam
- contain any personal information belonging to the poster or another person (such as address, phone number, email address)
- include material that is unlawful, libellous, fraudulent, defamatory, obscene, abusive, threatening, harassing, insulting or deemed confidential
- have the whole post or comment written in capital letters
- "bomb" the Facebook page with repetitive postings
- attempt to hijack the Facebook page by importing personal conflicts, agendas or grudges.
